

PLANTING GUIDE FOR JUNE-JULY 2026

- Temperature varies in SEQ Region for June between 4^o and 24^o Celsius
- Temperature varies in SEQ Region for July between 3^o and 23^o Celsius

Plant Name	Soil Temp Celsius	Soil pH	Harvest Period	Comments
Asian Greens	10-25	6.0-7.0	6-10 wks	Pak Choy, Wong Bok Tatsoi, Mizuna
Asparagus Crowns	8-16	6.5-7.0	2+ years	Sow seeds in Spring
Beans	15-30	6.0-7.5	16-20 wks	French, Climbing
Broad Beans	6-24	6.0-7.5	12-22 wks	
Beetroot	10-30	6.5-7.5	10-20 wks	To prevent corkiness, keep the top of the beet bulb covered
Broccoli	10-25	6.0-7.0	10-16 wks	Cut stem 10cm below centre head, new shoots will grow (broccolini)
Cabbage	7-25	6.0-6.5	8-16 wks	Small headed varieties mature faster
Carrot	10-30	6.5-7.5	10-12 wks	
Cauliflower	10-25	6.5-7.0	14-18 wks	Multihead variety can be harvested in 10 weeks
Celery	13-21	6.5-7.5	16-18 wks	Pick outside stalks as required
Garlic	10-35	6.5-7.5	7-8 mths	soft neck, daylight neutral e.g Italian Pink or Italian Red
Kale	10-25	6.0-7.5	7-9 wks	
kohlrabi	10-30	6.0-7.5	7-10 wks	
Leek	10-30	6.0-7.5	16-18 wks	
Lettuce	10-25	6.0-7.0	6 wks	Choose the winter loving types like Cos and Iceberg
Onions Bulb	15-24	6.0-7.0	6-8 mths	Short daylight (10-12hrs) e.g Australian Brown, Red Creole
Peas	5-20	6.0-7.5	9-11 wks	Pick frequently to increase production
Potato-	5-24	5.5-6.5	15-20 wks	Sow seed potatoes which are free of disease
Radish	10-30	6.0-7.0	5-7 wks	
Rocket	10-25	6.0-7.5	3-5 wks	
Shallots/Eschalot	15-25	6.0-7.0	120 days	
Silverbeet	10-30	6.0-7.5	7-12 wks	
Snow Peas	5-20	6.0-7.5	12-14 wks	Pick frequently to increase production
Spinach-	5-25	6.5-7.0	8-10 wks	English
Tomatoes Large	15-35	6.0-6.8	8-16 wks	Frost sensitive
