

PLANTING GUIDE FOR AUGUST-SEPTEMBER 2026

- Temperature varies in SEQ Region for August between 6° and 24°Celsius
- Temperature varies in SEQ Region for September between 8° and 28°Celsius

Asian Greens	10-25	6.0-7.0	6-10 wks	Pak Choy, Wong Bok Tatsoi, Mizuna
Asparagus	8-16	6.5-7.0	2+ years	Crowns, seeds in Spring
Beans	15-30	6.0-7.5	16-20 wks	French, Climbing
Beetroot	10-30	6.5-7.5	10-20 wks	To prevent corkiness, keep the top of the beet bulb covered
Cabbage	7-25	6.0-6.5	8-16 wks	Small headed varieties mature faster e.g. sugarloaf
Capsicum	20-35	5.5-7.0	8-10 wks	
Carrot	10-30	6.5-7.5	10-12 wks	
Cassava	25-30	5.5-6.5	8-12 mths	Tuberous roots
Chilli	20-35	5.5-7.0	varies	
Eggplant	20-35	5.5-7.0	12-15 wks	
Lettuce	10-25	6.0-7.0	6 wks	
Melons (Sep)	15-35	5.5-6.5	10-16 wks	Rockmelon, Watermelon
Peanut raw (Sep)	25-30	6.0-6.5	14-16 wks	
Potato-	5-24	5.5-6.5	15-20 wks	Sow seed potatoes which are free of disease
Pumpkin	20-35	6.0-6.5	15-20 wks	Flowers after summer solstice
Radish	10-30	6.0-7.0	5-7 wks	
Rhubarb	10-23	6.0-7.0	2+ years	Twist and pull stalk, do not cut
Rocket	10-25	6.0-7.5	3-5 wks	
Rosella (Sep)	20-35	5.5-7.0	20-24 wks	
Silverbeet	10-30	6.0-7.5	7-12 wks	
Snow Peas	5-20	6.0-7.5	12-14 wks	Pick frequently to increase production
Squash (Sep)	21-35	5.5-7.0	7-8 wks	
Sunflowers (Sep)	10-25	6.0-7.5	10-12 wks	Need full sunlight 60-90 days
Sweet potato (Sep)	16-25	5.3-5.6	16-20 wks	
Tomatoes	15-35	6.0-6.8	8-16 wks	Frost sensitive
Warrigal Greens	18-35	6.0-7.0	8-10 wks	
Zucchini	21-35	5.5-7.0	6-9 wks
